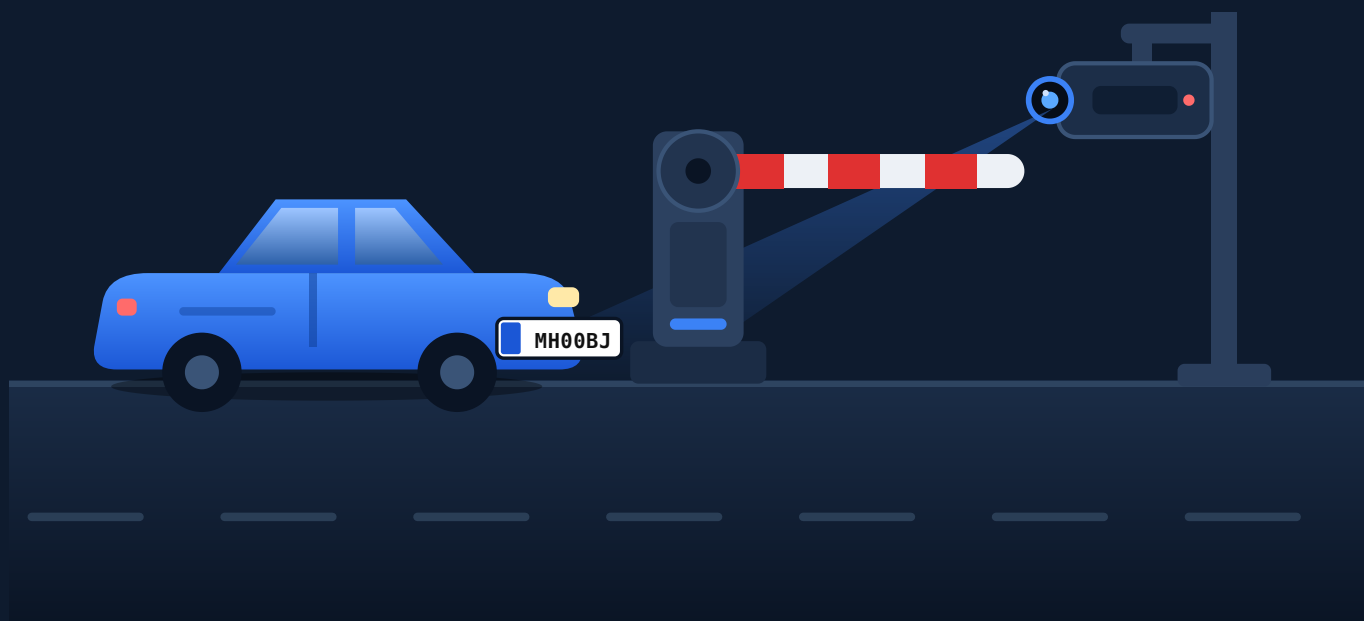

A camera, a barrier, and a phone in the guard's hand

No computer at the gate, no server in a cupboard, nothing to maintain on site. Smartie Gate Pro connects to the boom barrier you already have, through a relay board on the same open and close inputs its manual buttons use.

1

The camera sees the plate

An ANPR camera at the lane photographs each arriving vehicle. It runs on your existing WiFi — no cabling across the compound, no static IP, no router changes.

2

The number is read and checked

The plate is matched against the site's register in about a second. Blocked and expired vehicles are flagged with the reason, so the guard can say something useful to the driver.

3

Registered vehicles go straight through

The barrier opens on its own. Anything unrecognised appears on the guard's phone with a clear allow or stop, and he decides. He is never taken out of the loop.

4

Everything is written down

Plate, direction, gate, time and the guard on duty. Searchable in seconds, exportable to Excel, and impossible to back-date.



Works offline

The guard app records everything without internet and syncs when the line returns. The barrier can always be opened by hand.



Seven languages

Hindi, Marathi, Gujarati, Tamil, Kannada, Punjabi and English — and the verdict spoken aloud so the guard can watch the vehicle.



Nothing can be edited away

Every entry, exit and override carries the name of who did it. A correction is recorded as a correction, beside the original.

What it does not do

It does not replace your security guard. It reads plates and keeps records; somebody still has to be at the gate to look at people, judge situations and stop what should be stopped. Plate reading is less reliable in heavy rain or when a plate is dirty or damaged.

THREE PRODUCTS

One system, shaped to the gate it stands at

A parking lot has no flats. A building site has no residents. The app shows each one only what it actually uses — same hardware, same sign-in, different screens.



Society Parking

Housing societies & gated communities

Member vehicles open the barrier automatically. Visitors are approved by the flat they came to see, with a photograph. Dues, fines, notices and routine tasks run from one place.

- ✓ Members, flats and vehicle quotas
- ✓ Visitor approval on the resident's phone
- ✓ Pedestrian and domestic-help register
- ✓ Parking charges, fines and receipts
- ✓ Emergency button at the gate
- ✓ Who is inside, right now

Construction sites & warehouses

For the gate where material goes out and nobody can prove, three weeks later, what was on the truck. Every movement carries photographs and cannot be edited afterwards.

- ✓ Material in and out, by supplier
- ✓ Up to seven photographs a movement
- ✓ Approved suppliers and their people
- ✓ Carried items listed before the road
- ✓ Exit permission on the record
- ✓ Live list of who is still on site



Smartie Pay & Park

Paid parking, malls, hospitals, stations

A paid lot run from the number plate. Timed from the moment it is read, charged on the way out, and the evening's cash counted against what the tickets say it should be.

- ✓ Tariffs you set — hourly, daily, slab
- ✓ Monthly and season passes by plate
- ✓ Collections counted per guard, per shift
- ✓ Live occupancy from the plates
- ✓ Lane screens showing the fee
- ✓ Your branding on slips and passes



SOCIETY PARKING

The gate stops being an argument

Residents drive through without stopping. Every visitor, delivery and helper is recorded with a photograph and approved by the flat they came to see.

1

A car arrives at the boom

The camera reads the plate before it stops. A registered member vehicle opens the barrier — no tag, no sticker, nothing to lend to a friend.

2

An unknown plate goes to the guard

Never refused automatically. He sees the plate, the photograph and the verdict, and decides.

3

The visitor is photographed in ten seconds

Name, phone, who they have come to see, and a face photograph. People on foot use the same register.

4

The flat decides from wherever they are

Allow, decline, or set how long they may stay. If nobody answers, the guard may allow it on his own name — recorded as exactly that.

5

They leave, and that is recorded too

An entry with no exit is the thing worth noticing.

WHO IT SUITS

Buildings of 40 flats to townships of 5,000. The shape of the problem is the same; only the number of gates changes.

Typical plan

Society — ₹2,999/month, 2 barriers, 2 cameras, up to 250 members

Small building

Starter — ₹1,499/month, one barrier and one camera

Large or township

Pro or **Campus** — up to 12 barriers

At the gate

ANPR camera per lane, the barrier, an Android phone for the guard

From you

An internet connection. No computer, no server

Roles

Society Admin, Society Manager, Gate Guard, Member

IN USE

A 180-flat society in Mumbai: residents stopped queueing behind the visitor book, and the committee can answer who was at the gate at 11pm on the 4th with a photograph instead of an argument.



Members and vehicles

Flat-wise register with quotas, validity and charges, from bike to crane.



Resident app

Their vehicles, visitors and dues. Approvals with a photograph.



Charges and fines

Nothing can be deleted — only waived, with a reason on the record.



IND

SMARTIE SITEGUARD

Nothing leaves the site unphotographed

Built for the gate where material goes out and nobody can prove, three weeks later, what was actually on the truck.

1

The vehicle is read at the lane

Approved supplier vehicles are recognised; anything unknown stops with the guard.

2

The load is photographed, not described

Up to seven photographs a movement: the person, the plate, the load from more than one angle, the paperwork.

3

Material recorded against the supplier

What it was, how much, which firm sent it, and who received it.

4

A person on foot is logged in — and owed an exit

Somebody who entered and never left shows on the live list of who is inside.

5

Leaving needs a decision, recorded either way

The guard may allow it himself or ask the office. Both carry a name, a time and a reason.

WHO IT SUITS

Construction sites, warehouses and yards. Anywhere the valuable thing is what leaves, not what arrives.

Included with

Campus — ₹9,999/month, 12 barriers, 20 cameras, 1-year history

Or as an add-on

Construction mode — ₹1,200/month on any other plan

Photo retention

1 year on Campus; 2-year retention is a ₹500/month add-on

At the gate

ANPR camera, barrier, and an Android phone per gate

Roles

Site Owner, Site Manager, Gate Guard

Note

The barrier is for vehicles. People on foot are a register — the boom does not move for a pedestrian, by design

IN USE

A site storekeeper disputes a steel delivery three weeks later. The register has the truck, the plate, the load and the gate pass — photographed at 6:40am — so the argument lasts one minute instead of a fortnight.



Material in and out

Searchable by material, by firm or by date, each against its photographs.



Carried items

What a person is taking out, listed at the gate. This is the one that pays for itself.



Who is still inside

Vehicles and people, live — not discovered at handover.



SMARTIE PAY & PARK

The lot counts itself

A paid lot run from the number plate. Timed on the way in, charged on the way out, and the evening's cash counted against what the tickets say it should be.

1

The plate starts the clock

Read at the entry lane, so the duration is not somebody's estimate written on a slip.

2

Pass holders simply drive in

Recognised by plate. They never queue behind somebody paying cash.

3

The fee is worked out at the exit lane

Against the tariff you set. The lane screen shows it to the driver.

4

The guard collects, and the collection is his

Recorded against his shift, against the tickets actually issued.

5

The evening's numbers are visible the same evening

A gap shows up while the shift is still fresh enough to ask about.

WHO IT SUITS

Commercial lots, malls, hospitals and stations. Anywhere vehicles are charged by time and the cash is counted by hand.

Typical plan

Pro — ₹4,999/month, 4 barriers, 6 cameras, 180-day history

Larger or multi-level

Campus — ₹9,999/month, 12 barriers, 20 cameras

Busy lanes

Extra barrier ₹600 and extra camera ₹400, per month each

At the lane

ANPR camera per lane, the barrier, an Android phone per guard

Roles

Parking Owner, Parking Manager, Gate Guard

Note

Entry and exit lanes are configured separately, so a camera never opens the wrong barrier

IN USE

A commercial lot where the cash never quite matched the count. Tickets are now raised by the plate rather than by hand, and the shortfall is visible the same evening rather than at the end of the month.



Tariffs you set

Hourly, daily or by slab, per lot. Changes apply to the next vehicle in, not retrospectively.



Passes for regulars

Monthly and season passes tied to the plate. Nothing to show, nothing to lose.



Collections, counted

Per guard, per shift. This is the number the product exists to make honest.

PACKAGES

Per site, per month. No setup fee for the software.

Priced by gates and cameras, not per resident. A society does not get more expensive because a flat changed hands.

QUESTIONS

The things committees actually ask

Does it work with our existing boom barrier?

Yes. It connects to the barrier's own open and close inputs through a relay board, exactly as its manual buttons do.

What happens at night?

The camera has night vision and is set up for plate reading after dark. Reading is less reliable in heavy rain or when a plate is dirty or damaged.

What if the internet fails?

Plates stop being read, but the guard can always open the barrier by hand. Entries he records are saved on his phone and sent up when the connection returns.

Who can see our records?

Your manager and committee. Guards see their own gate's log. Residents see only their own visitors. One society can never see another's data.

How long does installation take?

A day for most societies. A technician fits the camera and relay, configures the gate, and trains your manager and guards in person before leaving.

Could someone copy a plate to get in?

They could, as with any plate-reading system anywhere in the world. That is why there is still a guard, and why every entry is recorded with a photograph.

NEXT STEP

A site visit costs you nothing

A technician visits, looks at your barrier and your approach lane, and tells you honestly whether this will work well at your site. If it is the wrong fit we will say so — an unhappy site is worse for us than no site.
